THIS MATTER is on remand to the Board of Assessment Appeals after entry of the Supreme Court’s decision on Case No. 99SC926. 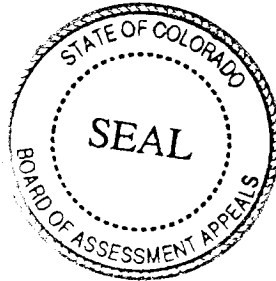
