THE BOARD OF ASSESSMENT APPEALS received Respondent’s Motion to Dismiss on January 31, 2011. The Board did not receive a response from Petitioner.

ORDER:

Petitioner was previously granted an abatement, in part, by Respondent and received notice of the decision on April 6, 2009. Petitioner had 30 days from the date of mailing of Respondent’s decision, or until May 6, 2009, to appeal to the Board (Section 39-10-114.5(2), C.R.S.). Petitioner then filed an additional abatement petition with Respondent for the same property on October 8, 2009, which was denied by Respondent based on res judicata principles. The Board received Petitioner’s petition on January 14, 2010. The Board concludes Petitioner’s petition was not filed timely and grants Respondent’s Motion to Dismiss.

The petition is dismissed.
