Southwest Colorado Economic Drivers Study	Archuleta, Dolores, Montezuma and San Juan Counties, and Region 9 Economic Development District of SW Colorado	The Economic Drivers Study, spearheaded by the Region 9 Economic Development District of SW Colorado, will identify the "base industries" that bring jobs and income into the region. The study will present an analysis of the economic drivers in each county. The focus will be on quantifying the impact of second homes and comparing their effects to other economic drivers.	\$22,000
Park County Cost of Community Services Study	Park County, Town of Alma, Town of Fairplay	The project consists of developing a cost of community services study for Park County and the Towns of Fairplay and Alma. The study will provide a ratio of tax revenue to service costs for residential, commercial/industrial, and vacant/agricultural land uses. The study will help predict the fiscal effects of different densities of development.	\$30,000
Woodland Park Healthy Forest Initiative	City of Woodland Park, Teller County, Colorado State Forest Service, US Forest Service, Coalition for the Upper South Platte	The Woodland Park Healthy Forest Initiative is a partnership of numerous public and private agencies that are striving to create a demonstration project for wildfire fuels mitigation in the Wildland-Urban Interface around Woodland Park. This project element will evaluate local building and landscaping codes with the goal of developing fire-wise subdivision standards; coordinate planning efforts of all partners, and package the lessons learned so other communities may benefit from the experiences of this collaborative effort.	\$6,000
